## **IN THE MATTER OF** an Order issued under Section 21 of the *Wildlife Act*

## MINISTERIAL ORDER

- I. WHEREAS subsection 21(1) of Chapter 504 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989, the *Wildlife Act* ("the Act") provides that, notwithstanding anything contained in the Act, the Minister of Natural Resources and Renewables may issue an Order prohibiting hunting or a method of hunting in any defined area of the province for a period considered necessary for the proper management of wildlife in that area;
- II. AND WHEREAS, notwithstanding the Act and any regulations made under the Act, including section 5 of the *Moose Hunting Regulations*, the Minister considers it necessary for the proper management of moose to prohibit hunting certain moose within specified areas of the province for a specified duration;
- III. AND WHEREAS, limiting the harvesting of female moose (antlerless moose) is a strategy that supports moose population conservation;
- IV. AND WHEREAS, data gathered during the winter 2023 Cape Breton moose survey showed a population decline compared to the estimated population in 2015, and, in response to this survey, the Minister believes that measures are necessary for proper management of wildlife in certain areas;

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The Minister of Natural Resources and Renewables, under subsection 21(1) of the *Wildlife Act*, hereby prohibits the hunting of antlerless moose within the lands designated as Moose Management Zone 1, 2 3 4 and 5 of the province in the *Moose Hunting Regulations* N.S Reg. 90/88.

This Order is effective on Monday, September 11, 2023, and expires on Friday December 15, 2023, inclusive of these dates.

**ANY PERSON** who contravenes this Order may be liable to prosecution under subsection 21(3) of the *Wildlife Act*.
