HANTAVIRUS PULMONARY SYNDROME

Case Definition

Confirmed Case:

Clinical illness with laboratory confirmation of infection:

Detection of IgM antibodies to hantavirus.

OR

- Detection of a significant (e.g. fourfold or greater) increase in hantavirus-specific IgG.
- Detection of hantavirus RNA in an appropriate clinical specimen.

OR

Detection of hantavirus antigen by immunohistochemistry.

Clinical Evidence

Characterized by:

A febrile (>38.3C oral) illness requiring supplemental oxygen.

AND

- Bilateral diffuse infiltrates (may resemble acute respiratory distress syndrome [ARDS]).
 AND
- Develops within 72 hours of hospitalization in a previously healthy person.

OR

 An unexplained illness resulting in death plus an autopsy examination demonstrating non-cardiogenic pulmonary edema without an identifiable specific cause of death.

Reporting Requirements

- Report confirmed cases immediately to DHW Surveillance Team.
- Enter into Panorama.
