HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV)

Case Definition

Confirmed Case:

Adults, Adolescents & Children ≥18 months:

• Detection of HIV antibody with confirmation (e.g. EIA screening with confirmation by Western blot or other confirmatory test).

OR

Detection of HIV nucleic acid (e.g. DNA PCR or plasma RNA).

OR

HIV p24 antigen with confirmation by neutralization assay.

OR

Isolation of HIV in culture.

Children <18 months (on two separate samples collected at different times):

Detection of HIV nucleic acid (e.g. DNA PCR or plasma RNA).

OR

HIV p24 antigen with confirmation by neutralization assay.

OR

Isolation of HIV in culture.

Clinical Evidence

Non-specific illness with fever, malaise, pharyngitis and lymphadenopathy for 1-2 weeks. Persons are then asymptomatic for months to years.

Reporting Requirements

Confirmed cases tested nominally or non-nominally are reported to DHW Surveillance Team via Panorama. For cases tested **anonymously**, no further reporting to DHW Surveillance Team is required.
