# **PNEUMOCOCCAL DISEASE, INVASIVE**

## **Case Definition**

#### **Confirmed Case:**

Clinical evidence of invasive disease (see Clinical Evidence) with laboratory confirmation of infection:

- Isolation of *Streptococcus pneumoniae* from a normally sterile site (excluding the middle ear and pleural cavity).
  OR
- Demonstration of S. pneumoniae DNA from a normally sterile site (excluding the middle ear and pleural cavity).

# **Clinical Evidence**

Clinical evidence associated with invasive disease manifests itself mainly as pneumonia with bacteremia, bacteremia without a known site of infection, and meningitis. Pneumonia without bacteremia is not notifiable.

• Report confirmed or probable cases to DHW Surveillance Team via Panorama.
