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Background:

In the event a previously issued aquaculture site is discontinued, the Department will conduct a performance review to determine if the site remains a suitable location for aquaculture. In such a case, the site will be added to the Registry of sites eligible for reallocation.

The registry of aquaculture sites eligible for reallocation contains details on the biophysical information related to the aquaculture site and can be found on the Department website at https://novascotia.ca/fish/aquaculture/public-information/

Following a competitive call for proposals, the aquaculture Administrator may select a proposal (with or without variations). A proponent whose proposal is selected has the exclusive right to apply for a new aquaculture licence and lease for a reallocated site, for a limited time.

Proposals may be submitted as follows:

Proposals will be accepted from 12:00 AM on the above Start Date to 11:59 PM on the above Deadline for Submissions Date.

Evaluating and Decision:

The criteria for selecting a proposal includes (but is not limited to):

- The technical and financial feasibility of the proposal
- The potential benefits to the community and Province;
- Any previous record of the proponent related to aquacultural operations; and
- The ability of the proponent to carry out the proposal.

Refer to the reallocation proposal form for more details on the criteria under consideration and how proposals are assessed.

The Aquaculture Administrator anticipates a decision on the call for proposals to be issued within 30 days following the deadline for submissions date, depending on the number of submissions received. The Administrator has the authority to select a proposal (as submitted or with variation) or to not select any proposals. The Administrator's decision will be posted on the department's website.

Site Description:

General Characteristics:

This site is located in the Northeast portion of Whitehead Harbour, Southwest of "Two Islands" and North of Burnt Island.

Water Quality:

This site is located within an area classified as "approved" for harvesting of all species of bivalve mollusks by the Canadian Shellfish Sanitation Program as of November 30, 2023.

Water Depth:

The most recent measurement indicated that the deepest portion of the site was approximately 10m. Water depth should be confirmed by proponents at this site.

Gear Present:

The former licence/lease holder has identified the following aquaculture gear that is currently present within the site: 40 backlines including rope, sinkers and pyramids. This gear is reported to be in operating condition. Following a Call for Proposals, the Department shall provide a successful proponent with contact information for the former licence/lease holder to offer the purchase of the aquaculture gear on site.

Site History:

Licence and Lease AQ#0616 was first issued in June, 1992 and was subsequently renewed until January 2018.

This site was discontinued on January 1, 2018. As of October 24, 2023, the former licence/lease holder has not been issued a Certificate of Discharge pursuant to Section 62 of the Aquaculture Licence and Lease Regulations.

Performance Reviews Conducted by Administrator:

A performance review was conducted on the aquacultural operation of site AQ#0616, pursuant to Sections 71-72 of the *Aquaculture Licence and Lease Regulations* (the "Regulations"). Any concerns raised during the Performance Review have been added to the above site details.

Based on the performance review conducted above, AQ#0616 has been entered into the registry of aquaculture sites available for reallocation in the Province of Nova Scotia under Reference Number RE#9010.
