



002.00 JURISDICTION AND MUTUAL AID/CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS

- 002.01 Approved: April 17, 2007
- 002.02 The police agency is to have a written policy and operational procedure that specifies the territorial boundaries of the agencies jurisdiction.
- 002.03 Operational or administrative policy and procedure approved by the police agency is to include and demonstrate:
 - (a) the police agencies responsibilities as they relate to concurrent jurisdictions involving other law enforcement agencies
 - (b) the terms of any departmental agreement concerning concurrent jurisdiction
 - (c) compliance, within practicable limitations, with requests for temporary assistance by another police department
 - (d) procedures for requesting federal, provincial or municipal police assistance
- 002.04 The police agency is to have a written policy and operational procedure that clearly defines the procedure when entering into a contractual agreement to provide paid police services.
- 002.05 Operational or administrative policy and procedure approved by the police agency is to demonstrate the inclusion within any contractual agreement of:
 - (a) a statement of the specific services to be provided
 - (b) specific language dealing with financial agreements between the parties
 - (c) specific records to be maintained concerning performance of services by the agency providing the service
 - (d) specific language dealing with duration, modification and termination of the contract
 - (e) specific language dealing with legal contingencies
 - (f) stipulation that the Police Agency providing the service maintains control over its personnel
 - (g) specific arrangements for the use of equipment and facilities
