## **Statement of Service as a Police Officer**

Retired Police offices are eligible for the award.

Consecutive years of service from the former Halifax Port Authority Police, Military Police or CNR Police, serving in Nova Scotia will be considered when calculating eligible years of service.

A Nova Scotia Police Long Service Award may be issued posthumously, if the deceased nominee meets the consecutive years of service requirement in Part B and is nominated within the current year.
