



## Training Opportunity: Community Counts for Crime Prevention

**Free hands-on, training sessions** about the use of the **Crime Prevention and Reduction Profiles** online tool are being held in your area.

*Crime Prevention and Reduction Profiles and Policy View on Community Counts* are tools that have been jointly developed by the Nova Scotia Departments of Justice and Finance. They provide statistical information about crime and associated risk factors for police districts and justice centres across Nova Scotia, and were developed with funding from the National Crime Prevention Centre (NCPC) using data from Statistics Canada.

This 3-hour workshop will provide training on: navigation and use of the system; an overview of the data available; and a description of recently added features such as detailed breakdowns of *crime by type* and *mapping community assets for crime prevention*.

We can accommodate a maximum of ten people per session as each participant will sit at a computer to learn how to use this new tool to understand data about the types and frequency of crime in your region. Space will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
