

**IN THE MATTER OF** the Nova Scotia Criminal Code Review Board

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** the accused, **Mohamed Issak**

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** a hearing held pursuant to s. 672.81(1) (Annual Hearing) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

**DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 27th day of January, 2016, the accused was found Non Criminally Responsible *on account of a mental disorder* on charges of assault with a weapon, contrary to Section 267(a) and breach of probation, contrary to Section 733.1(1)(a) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 22nd day of April 2024 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

**IT IS ORDERED** that the accused continue to be detained in the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital, with a community access ceiling level of L4.

**IT IS FURTHER DECLARED** that any period(s), past or present, in which the accused was or is unable to use full L2 privileges is a restriction of liberties, and the Hospital is directed to send notice(s) of any such period(s) which exceed(ed) seven days, forthwith.

**AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered

to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
