Updates

Happy New Year to you all. 2012 was a busy year for us, working on the design and development of the FRPA review program. Currently, we are working on developing a web-based data collection tool that will be ready to facilitate the FRPA review process pilots by the end of March 2013.

The FRPA review questions that will inform the review process have been drafted and suggested changes, by the Ad Hoc Advisory Group, have been incorporated. The review question assessment criteria is still under development and will also be reviewed with the Advisory Group.

Additionally, the content of the RPL & Labour Mobility website has been edited by a plain language consultant. Updates to the website are currently underway.

Regulatory bodies will be kept up to date on any changes the Review Office undergoes or any other pertinent information via e-mail. Please let me know if my email distribution list needs to be updated.

Annual Data Requirements

In December, the 2013 data requirements for regulatory bodies subject to FRPA were distributed. We will be asking that this data be submitted voluntarily for 2011 and 2012, if available. All regulatory bodies must start to collect this data as of 2013.

2011-12 Annual Report

The FRPA Annual Report has been presented to the members of the House of Assembly and will be posted on our web site.

Plain Language

The FRPA Review Office is currently in the process of developing a **Plain Language Webinar**. Webinar materials have been developed and the webinar development is underway. It will be hosted by the IQN (see below) so make sure you become a member with the IQN community. We are also working a **Plain Language Guide for Regulatory Bodies**. Stay tuned.
