Thank you to the College of Registered Nurses of Nova Scotia, the Nova Scotia Barristers' Society, the Interior Designers of Nova Scotia, and the Public Accounting Board of Nova Scotia. Once these reviews are complete (early June 2013) a report on the outcomes of the pilot will be drafted, necessary changes will be implemented and a review schedule will be prepared.
