## **Monthly Progress Report for September 2011**

## Activities September 1 to September 30, 2011

- Priority inspections continue for hospitals and schools.
  - Two hospitals inspected this month Cobequid Community Health Centre and North Cumberland Memorial Hospital. Six of 18 hospitals now inspected.
  - Inspections of schools in the Cape Breton region are underway. All 33 elementary schools in the Annapolis Valley Regional and Tri-County school boards have been inspected.
  - School audits have begun where schools are randomly selected in cooperation with the Department of Education. The audits involve the fire marshal reviewing a school's fire and safety plan.
- Activity reports for August from the Deputy Fire Marshals include 136 inspections and 17 investigations.
