

Domestic brush burning and campfires

Restrictions apply March 15 to October 15

No burning between 8am and 2pm

Restrictions are set at 2pm daily

ALLOWED
between 2pm
and 8am
(*GREEN areas*)

ALLOWED
only at certain
times
(*YELLOW areas*)

NOT ALLOWED
(campfires and
brush burning)
for your safety
(*RED areas*)

Please note: Check municipal bylaws first.

in winter

wildfire
risk is low.

Burning restrictions apply
to: domestic brush and
campfires. A PERMIT IS
STILL REQUIRED if
burning is for:

industrial land clearing,
agriculture, building
construction, blueberry
crops. See local DNR office.
