Domestic brush burning and campfires

Restrictions apply March 15 to October 15

No burning between 8am and 2pm Restrictions are set at 2pm daily

Map is updated daily to show where burning is:

ALLOWED between 2pm and 8am

(GREEN areas)

ALLOWED only at certain times

(YELLOW areas)

NOT ALLOWED (campfires and brush burning) for your safety

(RED areas)

Please note: Check municipal bylaws first.



Save your brush over summer to burn in winter when wildfire risk is low. Burning restrictions apply to: domestic brush and campfires. A PERMIT IS STILL REQUIRED if burning is for:

industrial land clearing, agriculture, building construction, blueberry crops. See local DNR office.
