## Nova Scotia Pesticide Certification Exam Schedule 2024-25

If you need pesticide applicator certification and are not using re-certification points or reciprocity, please register for one of the on-line exam-writing sessions listed below by submitting a completed *Application for Pesticide Certificate* to <a href="mailto:PesticideApplications@novascotia.ca">PesticideApplications@novascotia.ca</a>. We will need to receive it at least 5 business days in advance of the exam. The application form can be found at:

The payment must also be received 5 business days prior to be granted access to the exam session. Please send a cheque, made payable to *Minister of Finance*, to the NS Environment and Climate Change (NSECC) office located in Bedford, Kentville or Sydney (Attention: Regional Secretary). Please include a valid email address on your application so we can send you the information required to access the online exam. Please be aware that exam sessions have a limited number of seats available per session.

Before writing the exam, study the appropriate pesticide manual(s). The manuals can be found at <a href="https://www.novascotia.ca/nse/pests/applicatortraining.asp">https://www.novascotia.ca/nse/pests/applicatortraining.asp</a>. Agriculture, Domestic Vendor and Commercial Vendor classes have one manual. For other classes, see the Core Manual and the applicable Class Manual. You will need to achieve at least 75% on each of the exam(s) to pass. Only 1 class plus core exam can be written per session.

Once a complete application form, including a valid email address, and payment has been received, we will send you an email with instructions to create a Nova Scotia Login System username and password. You will also receive a separate email prior to the exam date containing your exam passwords.

There will be an in-person demonstration session the day before the actual exam to assist examinees with accessing and navigating the Moodle and BigBlueButton exam platforms. (Strongly recommended)

You will have three hours to complete the exam(s). Domestic and Commercial Vendors write one exam. All other classes write the Core and Class specific exams. Exams are closed book so you will not be permitted to reference any manuals or other resources during the exam. To complete the exam, you will need a laptop or desktop computer (no tablets or smartphones) with:

- Internet access to write the online exam and to enter the proctoring platform, and
- Audio and webcam capability for exam proctoring by NSECC. The webcam must be moveable to show us your room and desk.

There may be calculations as part of the exam. Therefore, a pen, paper and a calculator may be required.

Your results will be sent to you by email. The certification provided by this on-line exam will be valid for **5 years**. If you need to rewrite the exam, you will need to submit another application and applicable fee for the next online exam session.
