
Brule Point Game Sanctuary



This sanctuary was established in 1963 to provide feeding and resting habitat for migrating waterfowl, especially Canada geese. The area is not particularly heavily used by waterfowl. It consists of 76.2 hectares of privately owned land. Of this, 56.4 hectares is farmland. There is about 6 hectares of built-up land and roads, and about 14 hectares of forested land. Hunting of waterfowl and other game birds is prohibited.
