

Maccan River Wildlife Management Area



This wildlife management area was created in 1970 for the protection and management of some important waterfowl habitat. It has an area of 76.2 hectares. This includes 32 hectares of water and wetlands, 40 hectares of woodland and 4 hectares of utility corridor. Hunting and trapping are allowed in this wildlife management area.

This land was a gift to the Province of Nova Scotia with the condition that it become a wildlife management area so it must continue to have this designation.
