

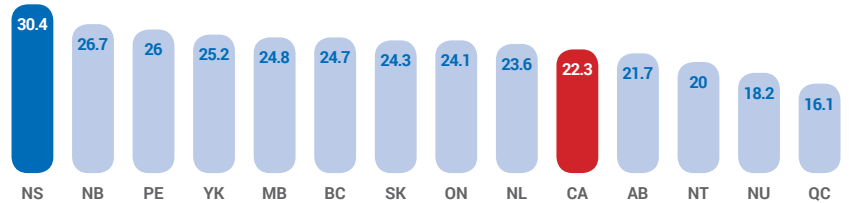


Disability in Nova Scotia

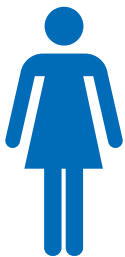
of Nova Scotians 15 years and older have at least one disability
