

How to Complete the “Application For License To Operate” Form

Nova Scotia Department of Agriculture is now licensing fur farms based on sites and not individuals. This means that **only one license will be issued per site.**

Only **one** License to Operate form should be filled out and submitted for each site. This means that **all operators on the site** must be included on one application for license to operate form. The landowner information must also be included on this form.

Note: Operator(s) are considered to be the person/business that owns the mink. All mink owners must be accounted for.

What if I operate multiple sites?

If you operate multiple sites you must submit a separate Application For License To Operate form and fee for each site.

What if mink and foxes are located on the same site?

A second Application For License To Operate form and fee will need to be submitted if more than one species of prescribed animal is housed on a site. For example, if mink and fox are both housed on one site, two Application For License To Operate forms will need to be completed and submitted for the site, one for mink and one for fox.
