Nova Scotia Children's Sports and Arts Refundable Tax Credit

Parents will be able to offset costs of their child's registration and expenses in sports and arts programs.

A new Children's Sports and Arts Refundable Tax Credit was introduced in Budget 2022-23.

It will be more accessible for about 175,000 children and youth under the age of 19 to participate in a wide variety of sports and arts programs. This benefits health and wellbeing and encourages active participation over a lifetime.

Parents can claim enrollment and registration fees for sports and the arts when filing taxes. This is a \$500 tax credit, effective Jan. 1, 2022.
