Ministerial Directive

on

Redeployment of Nova Scotia Health Authority Staff

To: Frank van Schaayk, Board Chair Nova Scotia Health Authority

I, Randy Delorey, Minister of Health and Wellness, Province of Nova Scotia, do hereby direct the Nova Scotia Health Authority (NSHA) pursuant to Section 46 of the *Public Service Act* and Section 11 of the *Health Authorities Act* with respect to redeployment of NSHA staff.

1. Purpose

1.1 To ensure effective utilization of health human resources to respond to the communicable disease, COVID-19, particularly in the health authority and long-term care facilities in the Province of Nova Scotia.

2. Application:

2.1 This Ministerial Directive applies to all NSHA staff, whether permanent or temporary, unionized or non-unionized, contract or otherwise engaged in provision of services in the NSHA.

3. Mandatory Requirements:

3.1 Pursuant to this Ministerial Directive, I hereby direct the NSHA to redeploy NSHA staff to such area or place in or at which such staff must perform their duties as directed by me or my delegates.

This Ministerial Directive is effective the date of signature and remains in effect until otherwise directed and communicated by me in my capacity as Minister of Health and Wellness.
