Site History:

Licence and lease no. 1157 were first issued to Wayne Turple on August 1, 1999 for a 5-year term (August 1, 1999 to August 1, 2004), for the suspended cultivation of Blue mussel, European oyster and Bay scallop on a 14.44 hectare site. In June, 2004, the licence and lease were renewed for a 5-year term (August 1, 2004 to August 1, 2009). In November, 2008, the licence and lease were assigned to Martin's Point Aquaculture Farm. In March, 2010, the licence and lease were renewed for a 5-year term (August 2, 2009 to August 1, 2014). In January, 2012, the licence and lease were reissued to Wayne Turple and given a new 5-year term (from October 25, 2011 to October 24, 2016). In October, 2015, the licence and lease were amended to add the species Giant sea scallop. In October, 2016, the licence was renewed for a 10-year term (October 25, 2016 to October 25, 2026) and the lease was renewed for a 20-year term (October 25, 2016 to October 25, 2036). In February, 2018, the licence and lease were assigned to Tina Dauphinee c/o K & H Capital. In August, 2018, the licence and lease were amended to modify Schedule "B" in order to comply with the Government of Canada requirements with respect to harvesting Giant sea scallops.

To be considered by the Administrator, a written submission from a member of the public must:

- Be received within the 30-day period indicated above (between the Start Date and End Date);
- Include the name, mailing address, civic address, phone number, and email of the person making the submission:
- Meet the criteria set out in Section 41 of the Aquaculture Licence and Lease Regulations.






Aquaculture Site




