Your child is participating in an interactive, informative program focusing on sportfishing recreation and an appreciation for Nova Scotia's aquatic environment.

Students participate in a classroom component and a hands-on fishing component.

What students should bring: L2F goes rain or shine so,

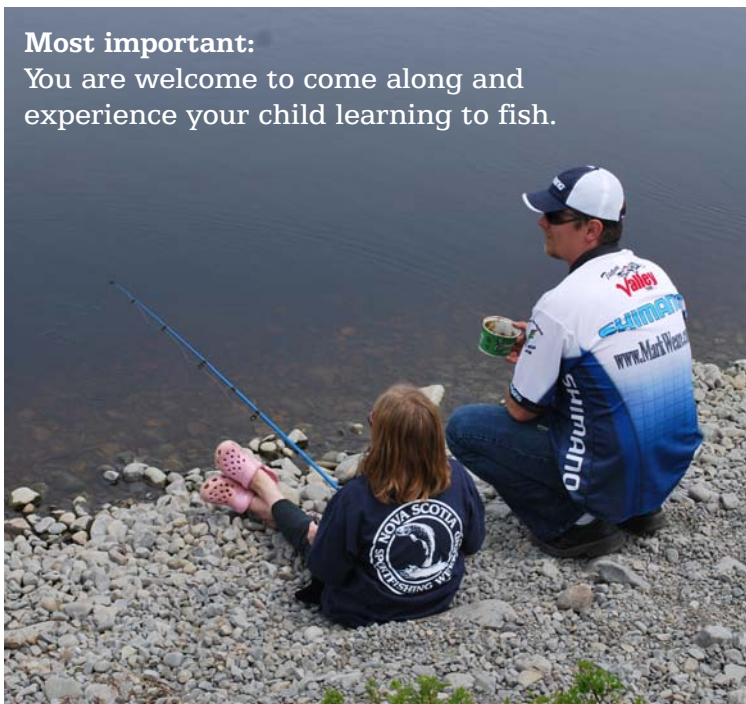
- rubber boots and raincoats
- warm clothes
- sunglasses, hat, and sunscreen
- fly spray
- snack, lunch, and water

During L2F students learn about **Catch & Keep** and **Catch & Release**. Students are allowed to bring fish home to eat and fish will be leaving the lake/pond in ziploc bags with some ice. These fish should go into the fridge and be eaten within a day or two.

Please remember to sign the photo release form and send it back to school with student.

You are welcome to come along and experience your child learning to fish.



The lake/pond will be stocked with Nova Scotia's provincial fish, the speckled trout, from one of our three provincial hatcheries—Fraser's Mills, McGowan Lake or Margaree. The fish will be arriving the same day or the day before our scheduled Learn to Fish program.
