3. Special Planning Areas

- **3.1.** Presentation by Ben Sivak, Manager of Planned Growth at the Halifax Regional Municipality (HRM) on the status of ongoing studies which included:
 - Background on the studies,
 - Project overview
 - General update
 - Update on Sandy Lake, Akoma Lands, Morris Lake Expansion and Hwy 102 Corridor studies,
 - Next steps

Highlights of the presentation and Panel's discussions:

- The studies are compiling information regarding environment, transportation infrastructure; and water and wastewater services infrastructure for four areas.
- The four areas subject to the studies are: Sandy Lake, Highway 102 West Corridor, Morris Lake, and Akoma.



- The studies will identify lands that are constrained, partially constrained, or not constrained for development, including:
 - Watercourse and Wetlands
 - Forest
 - Species at Risk
 - Landscape Connectivity
 - Surficial and Bedrock Geology
 - Steep Slopes
 - o Contaminated Sites, and
 - o Cultural Significance
- Targeted completion for Sandy Lake is Fall 2023.
- Targeted completion for the other three areas is March 2024.
- The Panel acknowledged the importance of these studies and offered any support required to ensure work completed in a thorough and timely fashion.
- 3.2 Special Planning Area: Bedford West 12 & 1-
- Proceeding with an interim development agreement for Bedford West 12 &1 Special Planning Area was discussed.
- Next steps: An estimated timeline for a development agreement for Bedford West 12 &1 will be provided at the next meeting.
- 3.3 Special Planning Area: Dartmouth Crossing -
- The status of the work on Dartmouth Crossing Special Planning Area was discussed.
- Next steps: Jarrod Baboushkin will arrange discussions with representatives from HRM Engineering and the developer to determine a path forward.
