- (a) motive fuel wholesaler \$1993.50
- (b) fuel oil wholesaler \$132.65

Application fee for 10-year motive fuel retailer and fuel oil retailer approval

13A The application fee for a 10-year motive fuel retailer and fuel oil retailer approval under the *Motive*

Fuel and Fuel Oil Approval Regulations is as follows:

- (a) motive fuel retailer \$436.00
- (b) fuel oil retailer. \$436.00

2 The regulations are further amended by repealing Section 16.

3 Section 17 of the regulations is repealed and the following Section substituted:

Application fee for renewal of fuel oil wholesaler approval

17 (1) The application fee for the renewal of a fuel oil wholesaler approval per year is as follows:

- (a) if the volume is less than 50 000 L \$13.30
- (b) if the volume is greater than 50 000 L, subject to the minimum fee set out in subsection (2), the application fee for the renewal of a fuel oil wholesaler approval per year under the *Motive Fuel and Fuel Oil Regulations* is calculated based on the total fuel oil volume sold at the rate per litre of \$0.000130.

(2) The minimum application fee for applying to renew a fuel oil wholesaler approval per year for a volume greater than 50 000 L is \$132.65.
