

**IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD
AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, Aptullah Adiloglu
AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to Section 672.47(1) (First Hearing)
of the Criminal Code**

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 7th day of January 2026, the accused was found *Not Criminally Responsible on account of a mental disorder* on charges of: Assault contrary to s. 266 and on a charge of Aggravated Assault contrary to s.268 and on a charge of Assault with a Weapon contrary to s.267(A) and on a charge of Cause Unnecessary Pain to a Kitten contrary to s.445.1 and on a charge of Theft Under \$5000 (x2) contrary to s.334(B) and on a charge of Theft contrary to s.344(1)(B) and on a charge of Possess, Uses or Traffics in a Credit Card contrary to s.342(1)(C) and on a charge of Uttering Threats to Kill, Poison or Injure an Animal or Bird that is the Property of Any Person contrary to s.264.1(1)(C) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 9th day of February 2026, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be detained at the said hospital with a Board community access ceiling level of L4, as currently defined.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
