DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 4th day of October, 2016, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code; and on the 13th day of June, 2016, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on three charges of mischief, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained in hospital;


AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 28th day of November, 2017, to make an order pursuant to section 672.81(2.1) and 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused. We leave in place the existing disposition of detention with a ceiling of L5.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order.
