## **Disposition Order**

Whereas on the sixth day of September, 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of two counts of assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code; assaulting a peace officer with a weapon contrary to section 270.01(1) of the Criminal Code; three counts of uttering threats to cause bodily harm, contrary to section 264.1(1) a) of the Criminal Code; possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose, contrary to section 88(1) of the Criminal Code; causing a disturbance by fighting, screaming, shouting, swearing, singing or using insulting or obscene language, contrary to section 175 (1)(a(i) of the Criminal Code; resists/obstructs a peace officer, contrary to section 129(a) of the Criminal Code; and failed to comply with recognizance, contrary to section 145(3) of the Criminal Code of Canada;

And whereas the accused is presently residing in the community on a Conditional Discharge;

And whereas a hearing was held by Zoom conference on the 22<sup>nd</sup>. day of June, 2021, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code of Canada;

And whereas the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

It is ordered that the accused be granted an Absolute Discharge.

**This is therefore** to command you, the administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in her majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order.
