DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 8th day of June 2006, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two charges of attempted murder, contrary to section 239 of the Criminal Code, one charge of assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code, and one charge of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently residing in the hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 4th day of May 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restrictions the liberties of Mr. Andrews.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
