DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 19th of May 2023, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of a mental disorder on a charge of assault causing bodily harm, contrary to s.267(b), a charge of break and enter with intent, contrary to s.348(1)(a), a charge of unlawful confinement, contrary to s.279(2), a charge of mischief in relation to property, contrary to s.430(3), a charge of uttering threats to cause bodily harm, contrary to s.264(1)(a), a charge of theft of a motor vehicle, contrary to s.333.1(1), a charge of at large on a release order, fails to comply, contrary to s.145(5)(a) x4, a charge of flight, contrary to s.320.17, a charge of dangerous operation, contrary to s.320.13(1), a charge of failure to stop at scene of an accident, contrary to s.320.16(1) and a charge of resists/obstructs peace officer, contrary to s.129(A) of the Criminal Code of Canada;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 4th day of July 2023 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be detained in the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling level of privileges of L2;

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
