DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 24th day of March, 2021, the accused was found not criminally responsible on a charge of uttering threats to cause death or bodily harm (s. 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code of Canada) and on April 23, 2021 of uttering threats to cause death (2. 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code of Canada x 6)

AND WHEREAS the accused is residing currently in the community at Spryfield, Nova Scotia;


AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on February 5, 2024 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.81(1) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be Absolutely discharged.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
