### **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of January 2022, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of assault of a peace officer contrary to s.270(1) of the Criminal Code, assault contrary to s. 266 of the Criminal Code and a charge of mischief contrary to s. 430(4) of the Criminal Code of Canada;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused currently resides in the community;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;
3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;

6. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
9. Appear before the Board when requested; and
10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the East Coast Forensic Hospital.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
