

**IN THE MATTER OF the Nova Scotia Criminal Code Review Board
AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, Graham Brunt
AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to Section 672.47(1) (First
Hearing) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.**

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 12th day of March 2026, the accused was found *Not Criminally Responsible on account of a mental disorder* on charges of: Assault with a Weapon contrary to s.267(A), and on a charge of Contravenes a Regulation to Store, Handle, Transport, Ship, Display Firearm contrary to s. 86(2) x2, and on a charge of Possession of Prohibited Weapon, Restricted Weapon, A Prohibited Device contrary to s.91(2) x17, and further on a charge of Possession of Weapon or Device Knowing its Possession is Unauthorized contrary to s.92(2) x17 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the accused presently resides in the community.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 5th day of May 2026, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;

3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
6. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
7. Appear before the Board when requested;
8. Do not possess any firearm, crossbow, prohibited weapon, restricted weapon, prohibited device, ammunition, or explosive device within the meaning of the Criminal Code.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
