## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 2018 the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two charges of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code:

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is residing in the hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused continue to be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
- 4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
- 6. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
- 7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by

the rules and regulations of the residence;

- 8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
- 9. Appear before the Board when requested; and
- 10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia;
