DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 17th of January 2020, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on charges of uttering a threat to members of the Halifax Regional Police to cause death or bodily harm, contrary to section 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code, setting fire to a dwelling house, contrary to section 433(a) of the Criminal Code and resisting arrest, contrary to section 129(a) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused presently resides at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 24th day of July 2023 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the restriction of liberties was justified.
