DISPOSITION ORDER (Amended – date change p.4)

WHEREAS on the 20th of July 2020, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two counts of assault with a weapon contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code and a charge of dangerous operation of a motor vehicle contrary to section 320.13 (1) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused presently resides in the community;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 16th day of August 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT an absolute discharge be granted;

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.
