IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, TIMOTHY SEYMOUR CLYKE AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.47(1) (first hearing) of the Criminal Code

## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 20<sup>th</sup> of July 2020, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two counts of assault with a weapon contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code and a charge of dangerous operation of a motor vehicle contrary to section 320.13 (1) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused presently resides in the community;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 22nd day of February 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Forensic Team, including the need for psychoeducational counselling;
- 4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Team;
- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Team;
- 6. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis (unless he can produce a prescription for medical cannabis) and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;

- 7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
- 8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
- 9. Appear before the Board when requested;
- 10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received by the Board; and
- 11.Not occupy the driver's seat of a motor vehicle.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
