AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81 (2.1) of the Criminal Code

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 22nd day of November 2011, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two charges of assaulting a police officer, contrary to section 270(1)(a) of the Criminal Code; a charge of resisting a peace officer, contrary to section 129(a) of the Criminal Code; two charges of breach of probation, contrary to section 733.1 of the Criminal Code; and a charge of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code;


AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 18th day of May 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.
