## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November 2011, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on two charges of assaulting a police officer, contrary to section 270(1)(a) of the Criminal Code; a charge of resisting a peace officer, contrary to section 129(a) of the Criminal Code; two charges of breach of probation, contrary to section 733.1 of the Criminal Code; and a charge of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 18th day of May 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.
