**AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(1) of the *Criminal Code of Canada***

**DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2012, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of assault causing bodily harm, contrary to section 267(b) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the hospital on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of an accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED** that the accused continue to be detained in hospital without privileges.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to him authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberty of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out herein pursuant to section 672.56(1).
