AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, Frank Duffy

AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to 672.47(1) (First Hearing) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 27th day of May 2026, the accused was found *Unfit to Stand Trial* on charges of: Possession of a Weapon for Dangerous Purpose contrary to s.88(1) x2 and on a charge of Possession of Prohibited Weapon, Restricted Weapon, A Prohibited Device contrary to s.91(2) and further on a charge of Possess Firearm While Prohibited contrary to s.117.01(1) and on a charge of Possession Over contrary to s.355(a) of the *Criminal Code of Canada* and further on a charge of Possession for Purpose of Trafficking contrary to s.5(2) x2 of the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act* .

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 7th day of July 2026 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made.

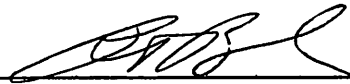
IT IS ORDERED THAT, having been found fit to stand trial, the accused be returned to the base court as soon as possible. Pending resumption of jurisdiction and disposition

by that Court, the accused is to be detained at the Hospital pursuant to s. 672.49(1) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
