

**IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD
AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, CHANTEL FARMER
AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held under section 672.82(1) of the Criminal Code**

DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 11th day of September, 2015, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on nine charges of abducting a person under the age of 14, contrary to section 281 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital, although previously granted a conditional discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 10th day of May, 2016, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED that the conditional discharge previously granted be continued, on the following terms:

1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. Maintain good mental health;
3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
4. Comply with follow up by the Forensic Community Program;
5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
6. Abstain from the use of alcohol and illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
7. Reside in premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
9. Appear before the Board when requested;
10. Remain within the province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board.

The Board would like to schedule a further review in about three months time to assess how Ms. Farmer's transition to the community has been conducted.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Services, Capital District Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this order. The Board delegates to him pursuant to section 672.56(1) the authority to direct that the restrictions on the liberties of the accused be increased or decreased within the limits set out in this disposition.
