DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 22nd of October 2019, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of assault, contrary to s. 266 of the Criminal Code and uttering threats, contrary to s.264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on a previously granted ceiling level of privileges of L5;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 6th day of July 2021 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused; the Review Board will recommend a transfer to the Ontario Review Board pursuant to section 672.86 of the Criminal Code; and the previously ordered hospital detention order with a ceiling of privileges of L5 and no contact with the victim be maintained;

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
