DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 23rd day of July 2020, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of mischief, contrary to section 430(a) of the Criminal Code, theft under \$5000 contrary to section 355(b) of the Criminal Code and possession under contrary to section 355(b) of the Criminal Code occurring on June 14, 2020 in Halifax, and assault with a weapon, contrary to s. 267(a) of the Criminal Code and assault, contrary to s. 266 of the Criminal Code occurring on June 15, 2020 in Halifax;

AND WHEREAS the accused is currently residing in the community with a ceiling level of privileges of Conditional Discharge;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 14th day of March 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restrictions the liberties of Mr. Gooden.

The Board leaves in place the previously granted Conditional Discharge.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order.

The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
