## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the on the 17th day of February 2022, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of a mental disorder on charges of uttering threats contrary to s. 264.1(1), and a charge of possession of a weapon for dangerous purpose contrary to s. 88 of the Criminal Code of Canada;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment, or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused be detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling level of privileges of L6.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
