## IN THE MATTER OF the NOVA SCOTIA REVIEW BOARD AND IN THE MATTER OF the accused, ELLEN KRASEMANN AND IN THE MATTER OF a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81 (1) of the Criminal Code

## **DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 2018, the accused was found unfit to stand trial on account of a mental disorder on charges of assault, contrary to section 266 of the Criminal Code, assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code, and three counts of uttering threats, contrary to section 264.1(1)(a) of the Criminal Code:

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently living in the community on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 1st day of March 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused continue to be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
- 4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;

5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;

6. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine

drug screening;

7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide

by the rules and regulations of the residence;

8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of

address;

9. Appear before the Board when requested;

10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been

received from the Board.

The Board finds that the accused remains unfit to stand trial.
