DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 10th of February 2021, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of second-degree murder, contrary to section 235 of the Criminal Code and a charge of interfering with human remains, contrary to section 182(b) of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the accused is presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling level of privileges of L5;

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on the 19th day of April 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused continued to be detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a ceiling level of privileges of L6;

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
