**AND IN THE MATTER OF** a hearing held pursuant to section 672.81(2.1) of the Criminal Code

**DISPOSITION ORDER**

**WHEREAS** on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charge of murder, contrary to section 235(1) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently detained in hospital;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Hospital on the 1st day of April, 2019, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.81(2.1) of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused continue to be detained in hospital with a ceiling of privileges of L5.

**The Board finds that the hospital was justified in restricting the liberties of the accused.**

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Administrator of the East Coast Forensic Hospital, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order
