DISPOSITION ORDER

WHEREAS on the 20th day of September 2024, the accused was found Unfit to Stand Trail on charges of: Operating A conveyance while Impaired, contrary to s.320.14(1)(a), and on a charge of Refuse to provide a breath demand, contrary to s.320.15(1)(a), and on a charge of Driving while prohibited, contrary to s.320.18(1)(a) of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the accused presently detained at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held at the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital on the 21st day of January 2025, to make a Disposition Order pursuant to s.672.54 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

AND WHEREAS the East Coast Forensic Psychiatric Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment,

IT IS ORDERED THAT the accused be detained at the East Coast Forensic Hospital with a Board community access ceiling level of L6.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to

the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in His Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).

The Board also finds that the accused continues to be unfit to stand trial.
