## DISPOSITION ORDER (Amended December 10, 2022)

**WHEREAS** on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January 2018, the accused was found not criminally responsible on account of mental disorder on a charges of assault with a weapon, contrary to section 267(a) of the Criminal Code, a charge of dangerous operation of a motor vehicle, contrary to section 249(1)(a) of the Criminal Code, a charge of mischief, contrary to section 430(4) of the Criminal Cod, failure to stop at an accident, contrary to section 252(1) of the Criminal Code, and a breach of recognizance, contrary to section 811 of the Criminal Code (four counts);

**AND WHEREAS** the accused is currently residing in the community on a previously granted Conditional Discharge;

**AND WHEREAS** a hearing was held on the 4th day of April 2022 to make a Disposition Order pursuant to section 672.54 of the Criminal Code;

**AND WHEREAS** the East Coast Forensic Hospital is designated for the custody, treatment or assessment of the accused, in respect of whom an assessment order, disposition or placement decision is made;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the accused continue to be conditionally discharged, on the following terms:

- 1. Keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
- 2. Maintain good mental health;
- 3. Adhere to the recommendations of the Community Mental Health Team;
- 4. Comply with follow-up by the Forensic Community Program;

- 5. Comply with conditions recommended by the Forensic Community Program;
- 6. Abstain from alcohol, cannabis and/or illicit drugs and comply with random urine drug screening;
- 7. Reside in the premises approved by the East Coast Forensic Hospital and abide by the rules and regulations of the residence;
- 8. Notify the Review Board and the East Coast Forensic Hospital of any change of address;
- 9. Appear before the Board when requested;
- 10. Remain within the Province of Nova Scotia unless authorization in writing has been received from the Board; and
- 11.Do not have any contact with Dr. Matthew Morgan or any member of his immediate family.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the accused is arrested pursuant to section 672.91 of the Criminal Code for a breach or anticipated breach of the terms of this disposition, they may, under section 672.92(1)(b) of the Criminal Code, be delivered to the East Coast Forensic Hospital, 88 Gloria McCluskey Avenue, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia.

**THIS IS THEREFORE TO COMMAND YOU**, the Director, Mental Health Program, Nova Scotia Health Authority, in Her Majesty's name, to execute the terms of this Order. The Board delegates to them the authority to increase or decrease the liberties of the accused pursuant to section 672.56(1).
